- Semen Analysis for 'Infertility Testing' or 'Fresh Sample' is strictly by appointment only (Phone 8171739).
- Sample should be produced by masturbation (Do Not Use a Condom) into a sterile leak-proof container.
- Sample should be collected after a minimum of 2 days and a maximum of 7 days sexual abstinence.
- If additional samples are required, the number of days of sexual abstinence should be as constant as possible at each visit.
- The sample needs to be complete and the man should report any loss of any fraction of the sample.
- Samples should be brought to the laboratory as soon as possible and within 1 hour of producing.
- The specimen container should be kept at ambient temperature, between 20°C and 37°C during transportation to the laboratory.
- Specimen container should be clearly labelled with the man's full name and date of birth and/or hospital number.
- Upon arrival at the laboratory the man should fill out RF-MICRO-0002 Request form before the sample is analysed.
- Results of the semen analysis will be returned to your referring doctor once complete. The lab does <u>not</u> give results to the patient.
- Post Vasectomy Samples should be brought to laboratory as soon as possible, or may be posted to the laboratory. Samples MUST be posted according to the correct Category B Biological substances (UN3373) regulations.
